As the A<u>n</u>angu Employment & Development Officer you will be responsible for supporting Anangu to transition successfully into employment with NPYWC by providing mentoring and support on the ground.

The successful candidate will have a community development approach, be a natural relationship builder and display excellent communication skills, particularly as a cross-cultural liaison. In addition, they will hold a relevant qualification in areas such as Training and Employment Services, Youth Work, Human Resources, Community Development or Business Administration and ideally would have previous experience working at a similar level within remote or regional communities.
