



## **Mobilisation Project Manager**

In this newly created position, the Mobilisation Project Manager will play a critical role in the end-to-end establishment of all new supportive housing programs. Working under the direction of the Project Director, you will lead the mobilisation of new services from planning through to operational readiness ensuring services are delivered on time, within scope and budget and aligned with service models, funding agreements and organisational standards.

The successful candidate will be responsible for translating approved service models into fully operational, trauma-informed and person-centred services ready for delivery. You will coordinate all pre-operational activities including workforce mobilisation, systems readiness, governance, stakeholder engagement and operational design.

You will have a proven track record delivering complex projects from planning through to implementation, along with a proficiency in service mobilisation, with the ability to translate service models into operational reality.

In addition, you will have impressive stakeholder engagement and relationship management skills, excellent written and verbal communication skills and a proficient governance, reporting and budget management capability.

If you are an experienced project professional who thrives in complex, multi-stakeholder environments and is passionate about creating meaningful social impact then we would like to hear from you. Candidates with experience in the Community Housing or Homelessness sector, or within WA Department of Housing will be held in high regard.

Please note, this is an initial 6-month contract position, with the possibility of a 6-month extension. There is also the option for the successful candidate to work as a contractor on this project if they are set up with their own ABN and can commit to full time hours.
